

PRIVACY POLICY

Agnikul Cosmos Private Limited

This Policy is effective from and was last updated on August 27, 2026. (“Effective Date”).

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 AGNIKUL COSMOS PRIVATE LIMITED (CIN: U74999TN2017PTC119779), a company incorporated under the Companies Act, 2013, having its registered office at 910, Syndicate Bank Colony, Anna Nagar West Extension, Chennai, Tamil Nadu – 600101, India, and its principal place of business at Rocket Factory – I, 1st Floor, A-Block, IIT Madras Research Park, Chennai, Tamil Nadu – 600113, India (together with its affiliates and group entities engaged in the design, manufacture, marketing, sale, and launch of orbital launch vehicles and related products and services, including without limitation Agnikul Cosmos Launch Vehicles Private Limited, (“Agnikul”, “Company”, “we”, “us” or “our”), is committed to protecting the privacy of individuals who interact with us. “You”, “your” or “user” means any individual who accesses or uses our websites (including agnikul.in and shop.agnikul.in, the “Cosmos Store”), books, purchases, or enquires about any product, mission, or launch service, communicates or interacts with the Company, applies for a career opportunity, enters into a commercial relationship with the Company, or whose personal data is otherwise processed by the Company.
- 1.2 This Privacy Policy (“Policy”) applies to all personal data collected by Agnikul across (i) our corporate and mission websites (agnikul.in and associated sub-domains); (ii) the Cosmos Store, our e-commerce platform for merchandise and related goods (shop.agnikul.in); (iii) our “Book My Launch” enquiry and booking service and any related mission-planning, payload, or contracting process; (iv) careers and recruitment; and (v) any other interaction, communication, or commercial relationship you have with us. This Policy explains what information we collect, why and how we collect it, how we use, disclose, and protect it, and the rights available to you in relation to your personal data.
- 1.3 This Policy must also be read in conjunction with and construed in accordance with the applicable laws of Republic of India, including without limitation, the provisions of the Information Technology Act, 2000 of India read with Information Technology (Reasonable Security Practices and Procedures and Sensitive Personal Data or Information) Rules, 2011, Information Technology (Intermediaries Guidelines) Rules, 2011 and other applicable rules; and Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023 (“DPDA”) read with Digital Personal Data Protection Rules, 2025 (“DPDP Rules”).
- 1.4 Given the nature of our business, certain information we collect, particularly information relating to payloads, missions, satellites, and launch specifications may also be subject to India’s export control regime, including the Special Chemicals, Organisms, Materials, Equipment and Technologies (SCOMET) list under the Foreign Trade Policy, and applicable end-use/end-user regulations. Such information is handled subject to additional confidentiality, access-control, and regulatory-reporting obligations described in Paragraph 5 below, over and above the protections in this Policy.
- 1.5 We reserve the right to amend, change, or update this Policy at our discretion. Material changes will be notified on our website and, where you have provided contact details, by email. We

recommend you keep your contact details current with us; we are not liable where notifications fail to reach you because contact details are inactive, incorrect, or not updated.

1.6 We do not knowingly sell your personal data, nor do we intend to do so.

2. YOUR CONSENT AND THIS NOTICE

- 2.1** By providing your information to the Company, accessing or using our websites, applying for employment, placing an order on the Cosmos Store, submitting a launch or payload enquiry, or otherwise interacting with us, you acknowledge that you have read and understood this Policy and, where required under applicable law, consent to the collection, use, storage, disclosure, and processing of your personal data as described in this Policy. Where we rely on your consent, we will, in accordance with the DPDPA, present the request for consent in clear and plain language, together with an itemised notice describing the personal data sought and the purpose of processing, and independently of any other information presented to you.
- 2.2** Where processing of your personal data is based on your consent, you may withdraw such consent at any time by contacting us at cofoundersOffice@agnikul.in. Withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal..
- 2.3** If you do not agree with this Policy, you should refrain from providing your information to us, or discontinue use of our websites and services, as applicable. Please note that declining to provide certain information (for example, shipping or payment details on the Cosmos Store, or payload and mission specifications for a launch booking) may mean we are unable to provide the corresponding product or service to you.
- 2.4** In addition to the rights available under applicable law, you have the right to grievance redressal (Paragraph 11) and the right to withdraw consent (Paragraph 10) in the manner described in this Policy, and the right to make a complaint to the Data Protection Board of India established under the DPDPA.
- 2.5** If you access or use our websites, place an order, or otherwise provide information to us from a jurisdiction outside India, including international customers of the Cosmos Store or international launch/payload customers - you do so at your own discretion and are responsible for complying with local laws applicable to you. We will process your information in accordance with this Policy and applicable Indian law, and in accordance with Paragraph 9 (cross-border transfer) where relevant.

3. INFORMATION WE COLLECT

3.1 Identity and contact information

Name, email address, mobile number, contact details, residential or billing address, demographic details, and, where applicable, employer or organisation details.

3.2 Corporate and business information

Where you engage with us on behalf of an organisation (as a prospective payload customer, vendor, supplier, investor, or business partner), we collect organisation name, business address, registration and tax identification details, corporate affiliations, and authorised signatory information.

3.3 Launch, mission, and payload information

Where you submit a launch enquiry, use “Book My Launch”, or otherwise engage us for launch vehicle or mission services, we collect information necessary to scope, contract, and deliver the mission, which may include:

- Payload specifications, mass, dimensions, orbital and mission parameters, and technical interface requirements;
- End-use and end-user information, and export-control or regulatory declarations required for launch licensing and compliance (including filings with IN-SPACe, ISRO, and other applicable Indian regulatory or licensing authorities);
- Commercial and contractual information, including quotations, launch service agreements, and mission schedules;
- Points of contact, technical and programme-management personnel details of the customer organisation.

This category of information is treated as confidential business and, in many cases, export-controlled information, and is subject to the enhanced access and disclosure controls described in Paragraphs 4.3 and 7.

3.4 Cosmos Store (e-commerce) information

When you browse, place an order, or check out on the Cosmos Store (shop.agnikul.in), we, our checkout platform provider, and our payment gateway collect:

- Contact details: email address and phone number;
- Shipping and billing details: name, address, apartment/suite, city, state, and PIN code;
- Order details: items purchased, order value, order history, and delivery/pickup preference;
- Payment information: card or other payment-instrument details, which are collected and processed directly by our PCI-DSS compliant payment gateway/processor. We do not store full payment card numbers, CVV, or card expiry details on our own systems;

3.5 Career information

When you apply for a career opportunity through our website, we collect professional details such as current job title, experience, highest qualification held, current employer, expected and current salary, photograph, resume, and cover letter, among other information depending on the role. Applications may in certain cases be processed through, or redirected to, third-party recruitment platforms or service providers integrated with our website; any personal data submitted through such platforms is also processed by the relevant third party in accordance with its own privacy policy and terms of use.

3.6 Technical and usage information

Internet protocol address, browser type and version, device identifiers, time zone setting and general location, operating system and platform, and the timing, frequency, and pattern of your visits, pages viewed, and links clicked on our websites, including the Cosmos Store checkout flow.

3.7 Communications

Information contained in, or relating to, any communication you send to us, whether through our website, contact forms, or any email address of the Company or its representatives, including customer support, vendor, career, and general enquiries.

3.8 Information from commercial relationships

Information collected or received in connection with your actual, potential, or contemplated relationship, engagement, or interaction with the Company whether as a customer, prospective customer, investor, shareholder, vendor, supplier, service provider, employee, director, consultant, business partner, or other stakeholder including payment and banking details, due-diligence and compliance information (including KYC), and communications and other records relevant to such relationship.

4. HOW WE USE YOUR INFORMATION

4.1 You acknowledge and agree that we use the information we collect, including but not limited to, for the following purposes:

- To present, operate, and improve our websites, the Cosmos Store, and our services for your use;
- To process, fulfil, ship, and deliver Cosmos Store orders, including sharing necessary details with logistics, courier, and payment partners;
- To process payments and prevent payment fraud, in conjunction with our payment gateway partner(s);
- To evaluate, scope, quote, contract, and deliver launch vehicle and mission services, including regulatory filings and licensing applications where required;
- To evaluate career applications and manage recruitment;
- To provide you with updates and information relating to our products, missions, and services, and for marketing and promotional purposes (where you have opted in, or as otherwise permitted by law);
- To send non-marketing commercial communications, including order confirmations, shipping updates, and service notices;
- To send email notifications, text messages, and push notifications that you have specifically requested;
- To detect and prevent fraud, unauthorised access, and other malicious activity;
- For compliance purposes, including as required by applicable law, regulation, licensing conditions (including space-sector and export-control regulation), or requested by any judicial process or governmental authority.

4.2 You acknowledge that you have knowledge that your information is being collected and of the purposes and manner of its use as described in this Policy.

4.3 Purpose limitation: Where you provide us information for a particular reason we will use that information in connection with, and limited to, that particular reason, and will not repurpose export-controlled or mission-confidential information for unrelated commercial use such as marketing.

4.4 Where applicable law requires us to collect additional information from you to comply with legal obligations, we will inform you at the relevant time and indicate whether provision of such information is mandatory, together with the consequences of not providing it, where applicable.

5. LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING UNDER THE DPDPA

- 5.1** We process your personal data on the basis of your consent, given in the manner described in Paragraph 2.
- 5.2** In certain circumstances recognised as “legitimate uses” under Section 7 of the DPDPA, we may process personal data without consent, including where: (i) you have voluntarily provided your personal data to us for a specified purpose and have not indicated that you do not consent to its use (for example, submitting a launch enquiry form); (ii) processing is necessary for compliance with any judgment, decree, or order, or for responding to a medical emergency, or for measures to ensure safety of, or provide assistance during any disaster or public order breakdown; (iii) processing is necessary for purposes related to employment, including recruitment, termination of employment, provision of any service or benefit to employees; or (iv) processing is necessary for other legitimate uses specified under the DPDPA and DPDP Rules.

6. DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

We do not sell your personal data. We may, however, share information as follows:

- 6.1** Business transfers: your information may be shared during a diligence process with counterparties and advisors, and transferred to a potential acquirer, successor, or assignee, as part of any proposed merger, acquisition, debt financing, sale of assets, or similar transaction, or in the event of insolvency, bankruptcy, or receivership.
- 6.2** Service providers: with our employees, business associates, and third-party service providers engaged to fulfil services on our behalf, including payment gateway/processor (for the Cosmos Store), logistics, courier and fulfilment partners, cloud hosting and IT infrastructure providers, email/SMS/communication platforms, and analytics providers. We may also use information internally for training, data analytics, research, troubleshooting, and to identify patterns for improvement of our services and websites.
- 6.3** Regulatory and legal requirements: information may be disclosed to regulators and government authorities, including the Indian National Space Promotion and Authorisation Centre (IN-SPACe), the Department of Space, ISRO, licensing and export-control authorities, tax and law-enforcement authorities, or as otherwise necessary to (i) satisfy applicable law, regulation, legal process, or governmental request; (ii) enforce this Policy, including investigation of potential violations; or (iii) detect, prevent, or address fraud, security, or technical issues.
- 6.4** Access to launch, mission, and payload information (Paragraph 3.3) is restricted on a need-to-know basis to personnel and contractors directly involved in mission execution, licensing, and export-control compliance, and is not shared with marketing, e-commerce, or unrelated business functions.
- 6.5** Any third party to whom we disclose personal data is required to adopt appropriate security measures consistent with applicable law, and, where they act as our processor, is bound by confidentiality and data-protection obligations.

7. WHERE WE STORE AND HOW WE PROTECT YOUR INFORMATION

- 7.1** We store personal data in India. Information you provide, subject to disclosure in accordance with this Policy, is maintained in a safe and secure manner.

- 7.2** We implement physical, electronic, and managerial safeguards in line with applicable law to protect your information against unauthorized access, unlawful alteration, disclosure, or destruction, including encryption of information processed by our payment gateway and restricted, role-based access to export-controlled mission data. No method of transmission or storage is 100% secure, and we are not liable for security breaches caused by factors beyond our reasonable control.
- 7.3** Access to your information is restricted to personnel and third parties necessary to fulfil obligations under this Policy, who are trained in handling data securely, who process information in encrypted form where applicable, and who are bound by confidentiality obligations.
- 7.4** Data breach notification: in the event of a personal data breach, we will, in accordance with the DPDPA and DPDP Rules, notify the Data Protection Board of India and affected individuals in the form, manner, and within the timelines prescribed under applicable law.
- 7.5** Retention. We retain personal data only for as long as necessary for the purposes described in this Policy, or as required by law, as set out below:

7.6 Upon completion of the applicable retention period, and where retention is no longer required by law, we will either archive or anonymise the information (so it can no longer be associated with or identify you) or securely delete it. We will comply with archival, anonymisation, or erasure requests within 90 (ninety) days of receipt, unless a longer period is required for us to comply with a legal obligation.

8. YOUR RIGHTS UNDER THE DPDPA

Subject to verification of your identity and any exceptions under applicable law, you have the following rights as a Data Principal:

- 8.1** Right to access: you may request a summary of the personal data we hold about you, the processing activities undertaken, and the identities of other data fiduciaries/processors with whom your data has been shared, together with a description of the data shared. How to request: email cofoundersOffice@agnikul.in with the subject “Data Access Request”. Timeline: we will respond within 30 days. Format: data will be provided in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format. Cost: any cost we reasonably incur in fulfilling the request may be passed on to you, where permitted by applicable law.
- 8.2** Right to correction and erasure: if your personal data is inaccurate, incomplete, or misleading, you may request correction; if it is no longer necessary for the purpose for which it was collected, or you withdraw your consent, you may request erasure, unless we are required to retain it by law. How to request: email cofoundersOffice@agnikul.in with the subject “Data Correction/Erasure Request”, including your account/order/enquiry reference and reason for the request. Timeline: we will action the request within 30 days, unless retention is legally required.
- 8.3** Right to grievance redressal: you may raise a grievance regarding processing of your personal data or exercise of your rights (Paragraph 11).
- 8.4** Right to nominate: you have the right to nominate another individual to exercise your rights under the DPDPA in the event of your death or incapacity. To register a nominee, email cofoundersOffice@agnikul.in with the subject “Nominee Registration”.
- 8.5** Right to withdraw consent: see Paragraph 10.
- 8.6** We will endeavour to respond to all requests within the timelines above; where a request is complex, we will inform you of any reasonable extension required.

9. CROSS-BORDER TRANSFER OF INFORMATION

- 9.1** We primarily store and process personal data in India. Where you are an international customer of the Cosmos Store, or an international customer/partner for launch and mission services, we may transfer your personal data outside India to the extent necessary to fulfil the order, contract, or enquiry (for example, to shipping or payment partners, or in connection with cross-border mission coordination).

9.2 Any such transfer will be carried out in accordance with Section 16 of the DPDPA, which permits transfer of personal data outside India except to countries or territories restricted by the Central Government by notification. We will not transfer personal data to any country or territory so restricted.

10. WITHDRAWAL OF CONSENT

10.1 Where we process your personal data on the basis of your consent, you may withdraw such consent at any time, with effect comparable to the ease with which you gave it, by emailing cofoundersOffice@agnikul.in with the subject “Withdraw Consent”.

10.2 Withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out prior to withdrawal, and we may continue to retain and process certain information where required to comply with a legal obligation (for example, regulatory, licensing, tax, or export-control record-keeping) notwithstanding withdrawal of consent. Withdrawing consent for order- or mission-critical data may mean we are unable to complete or continue an order, contract, or mission enquiry.

We will investigate and respond within the timelines above. For order or shipping-related issues on the Cosmos Store specifically, you may also contact cofoundersOffice@agnikul.in

12. COOKIES

12.1 We use cookies and similar tracking technologies on our websites, including the Cosmos Store checkout flow. A ‘cookie’ is a small packet of information stored on your browser by a server so that it can be read back on a later visit. Cookies help us recognise your device, remember preferences, understand usage patterns, process transactions securely, and improve our websites and services.

12.2 Categories of cookies we use include: (i) strictly necessary cookies required for core website and checkout functionality; (ii) performance/analytics cookies that help us understand how visitors use our websites; and (iii) preference and marketing cookies, used only where you have consented.

12.3 Most browsers allow you to control cookies, including whether to accept them and how to remove them. If you choose to block or erase cookies, certain features of our websites, including checkout on the Cosmos Store, may not function properly.

13. CHILDREN’S PRIVACY

Our websites, services, and business activities are not directed towards, and we do not knowingly collect or process personal data of, individuals under the age of 18 years. If you are under 18, please do not provide any personal information to us, place an order on the Cosmos Store, or otherwise use our websites or services without the involvement of a parent or lawful guardian, and in compliance with the consent requirements applicable to processing of a child's personal data under the DPDPA. By interacting with us, you represent that you are at least 18 years of age, or that you are acting with the verifiable consent of your parent or lawful guardian.

14. EXCEPTIONS UNDER THE DPDPA

Pursuant to Section 17 of the DPDPA, certain obligations otherwise applicable to us may not apply where processing is: (i) necessary for enforcing any legal right or claim; (ii) necessary for prevention, detection, investigation, or prosecution of any offence or contravention of law in India; (iii) in respect of personal data of individuals not situated in India, processed pursuant to a contract entered into with a person outside India; (iv) necessary for a scheme of merger, amalgamation, demerger, or similar restructuring approved by a competent court, tribunal, or authority; or (v) for ascertaining the financial information and assets/liabilities of a person who has defaulted on a loan or advance from a financial institution, subject to applicable disclosure laws.

15. THIRD-PARTY LINKS AND SERVICES

Our websites, including the Cosmos Store, may link to or integrate with third-party websites, applications, or platforms ("Third-Party Platforms") including our payment gateway and shipping/logistics partners that are not under our control. The privacy policies of Third-Party Platforms are not our responsibility, and we recommend you review the privacy policy and terms of any Third-Party Platform before providing information to it.

16. DISCLAIMER

- 16.1** We are not liable for any loss or damage arising from any disclosure (inadvertent or otherwise) of information concerning your account, or from any omission or inaccuracy in information so disclosed, whether or not pursuant to a legal process.
- 16.2** You expressly understand and agree that use of our websites and services is at your own risk. We shall, to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, not be responsible or liable for any information leak, data loss, data theft, data corruption, or illegal or wrongful use of data stored on our servers or third-party servers, or made available on our websites.

17. COMPLAINTS TO THE DATA PROTECTION BOARD OF INDIA

- 17.1** If you have concerns about, or are dissatisfied with, how we handle your information or our privacy practices, you have the right to seek redress under the DPDPA.
- 17.2** If your grievance remains unresolved after contacting us, or you are not satisfied with our response, you may escalate the matter to the Data Protection Board of India established under the DPDPA.
- 17.3** To file a complaint with the Board: (i) prepare your complaint, clearly outlining your name and contact information and a description of your concern; (ii) include details of any prior communication with us regarding the issue; (iii) submit your complaint through the Board's

official online complaint portal, attaching supporting documents where available; and (iv) retain the acknowledgment and unique complaint reference number issued to track your complaint.

18. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

This Policy is governed by the laws of India. Subject to the jurisdiction of the Data Protection Board of India in respect of matters under the DPDPA, the courts at Chennai, Tamil Nadu shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Policy.
